Policy for Societies wanting to have JSM as their official journal

- JSM subscriptions received through ISSM automatically include membership to ISSM's (reduction on ISSM meeting registration fees, access to JSM online, access to ISSM members section on website, access to Newsbulletin, access to ISSMlist);
- The Society/Organization applying should have aims that are compatible with ISSM's charitable aims;
- The Society/Organization applying should have compatible ethical, scientific and governance standards and should not be involved in/affiliated to/related to any other Society/Organization that could undermine ISSM's science integrity;
- The Society/Organization applying should be an international/global society with at least 50 paying members subscribed to the JSM;
- The Society/Organization applying provides ISSM with a list of subscribers on January 1st of each calender year or, in case of following years, with an updated list (changes clearly marked);
- The Society/Organization applying will make sure that full name, address and contact details (incl. e-mail address) are included on the list of subscribers and is solely responsible for supplying correct data;
- The Society/Organization applying will pay the ISSM the applicable individual membership fee per subscribed member by Swift Bank Transfer within 15 days after providing the subscriber data: distribution of JSM will start as soon as full payment has been received;
- Each Society/Organization applying should be reviewed and approved by the ISSM BoD before it can have the JSM as its official Journal.

When the above mentioned policy is accepted by the ISSM BoD, the ISSM will have a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in place to specify the relationship between ISSM and Societies wanting to have JSM as their official journal. The MoU needs to be signed by both parties.
